## SERVICES WE PROVIDE

### Education

We have a network of educational institutes ready and willing to support our military-connected members in finding the right education opportunities that will lead to higher-level learning and competitive edge workforce transition opportunities.

### Family and Wellness

Collaborate with Veteran Service Organizations, Division of Veteran Services, Department of Defense military installations, non-veteran entities, and individuals to navigate veterans, military serving, and family members to resources that promote mental wellness, physical health, wealth, and morale.

### Housing for Heroes

Collaborate and provide support in the following areas, but not limited to, the purchase of a home, renting, homelessness, retirement community placement, assisted living, and end of life care.

### Vet-preneur

Collaborate with all Federal, State, and local agencies that provide business coaching, planning, and funding support for start-up or growth opportunities.

### Workforce Transition

Support career-seeking opportunities for military-connected and the civilian community in resume review, applying for jobs, interviewing, career counseling (Initial, Ongoing, Promotion), networking, career home placement, certifications, and education.

### INDIVIDUAL

Membership shall be granted to all Veterans, Military Serving, or Family Members of any state in the United States of America and countries where military members are currently serving and have a desire to relocate to The State of Idaho.

### VETERAN SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS

Membership shall be granted to any veteran service organization whose purpose is to promote, provide and support the military-connected community. The organization's mission must deliver services and support to Veterans, Military Serving, or Family Members.

**Membership costs: FREE**

### COMMUNITY PARTNER

Membership shall be granted to any agency, organization, business, or association that does not have a direct affiliation with a veteran service organization, veteran mission, or stand-alone veteran-owned business.

Fees may be waived for the following reasons but are not limited to:

1. A reciprocating agreement of some form has been established to allow for reduced membership or free membership for the IDVCC individual members only.
2. Registration and designation that has been awarded to a community partner to be identified as an Idaho Veteran Friendly Employer or Veteran Owned Business.

### INDIVIDUAL NON-VETERAN

Membership shall be granted to any person that is not considered a Veteran, Military Serving, or Family Member and has a desire to support the mission of the IDVCC.

**Membership costs: \$75.00/Annually**

### SPONSORSHIP

Membership will be granted to any individual or entity, veteran, or non-veteran.

Benefits of Sponsorship:

1. Includes Community Partner membership
2. Promotion of entity will be recognized on the Idaho VCC website, social media, marketing, and/or promotional materials, and/or during events.
3. Approval to use the IDVCC logo for any entity website, marketing, and/or promotional materials during events. The IDVCC logo will be provided for use.
4. Co-branding will be authorized with the approval of the Executive Director.
5. Sponsors will be authorized to provide a representation of one person from their entity to be a member of any of the following Committees: Education, Family and Wellness, Housing for Heroes, Vet-prenuer, and/or Workforce Development.
